Th 1. man casts off and his Partner follows him, the man goes quite round; the woman slips up the middle, the woman casts off and goes quite round: the 1. man slips up the middle, the 1. cu. cross over below the 2. cu. and cross up into their own places again, then right and left quite round into the 2. couples places.

longways duple minor

- A1 1-4 The first lady casts down behind her neighbour, crosses the set and moves into her partner's place. The first man follows her, but he cuts up between the second couple, and moves into her place (12).
- A2 1-4 Similarly, the second man casts up and moves round into his partner's place: she follows him round, but cuts down between the first couple into his place. All are now improper.
- B1 1-4 Couple 1 cross Rsh and move down as couple 2 half two-hand turn on the spot, and lead up (6). All two-hand turn partner in progressed places (6).
- B2 1-4 Partners facing, 4 changes of rights and lefts, with hands (3 steps each).

Notes

1. The first half of the dance was for the first couple only.
2. I have added the two-hand turn at the end of B1.
